

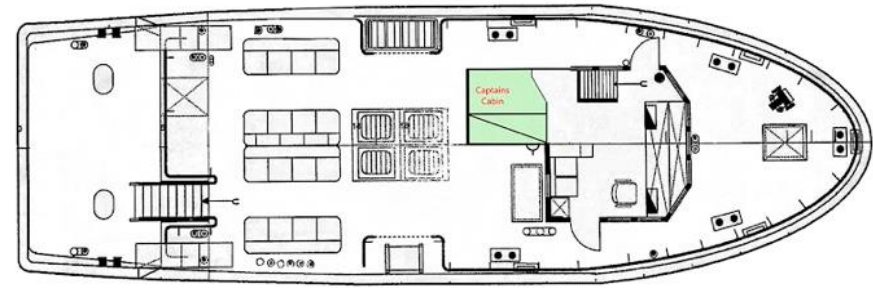

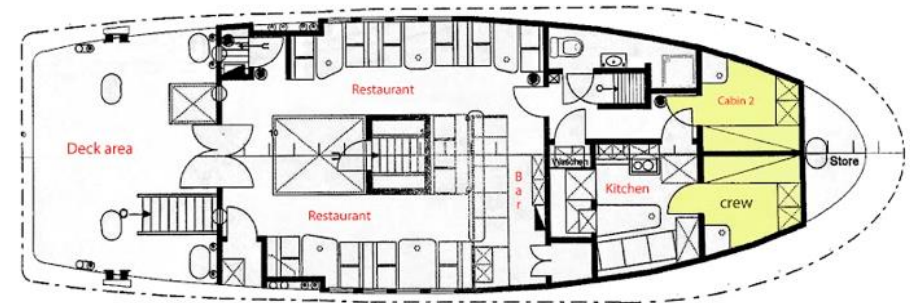

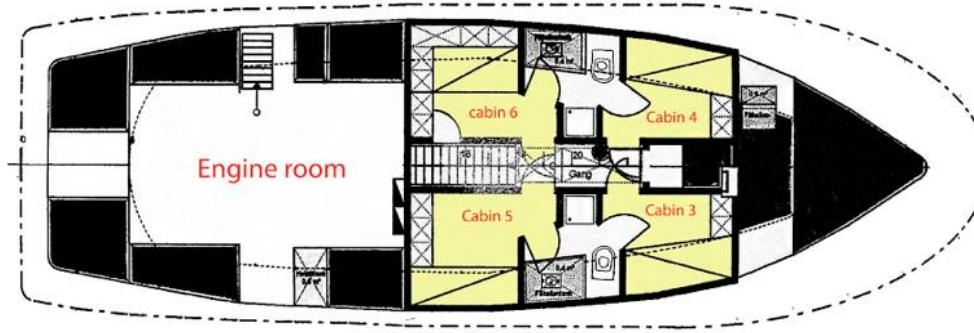
DECK PLAN

TEXT DESCRIPTION

“MS Leone” is our smallest expedition vessel. It was originally used as a fishing vessel, before it was rebuilt as a small passenger vessel for the Norwegian Coast and polar waters.

This vessel can accommodate up to 10 guests in five double cabins. We have 3 bathrooms with showers on board.

“MS Leone” is equipped with a big, comfortable saloon in the center of the vessel. This area also features a bar and can be used as a restaurant or as an area to just hang out, play cards or relax.

One of the advantages of this vessel, is the spacious outdoor deck top deck. This is why we were able to add a Jacuzzi for the comfort of our guests on there.

There is a really relaxed and family atmosphere on board. Our crew is working closely with our guests to support them as best as possible and to make their cruise with MS Leone an unforgettable one. Guests are also welcome to visit our captain in the wheelhouse at almost any time.

We can also take a Zodiac on board, which can be used for wildlife watching, exploring shallow waters and to do water sports, like water skiing.
